Mr. Jonathan Jezowski

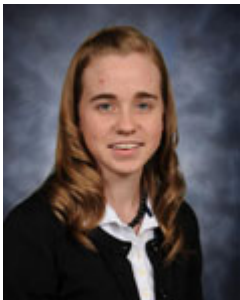


Jonathan graduated from Northland International University in
